**Dates:** 1863-2018

**Extent:** 1.3 metres of textual records

**Administrative History:** A pastoral charge consists of one or more communities of faith under the spiritual leadership of a minister. The pastoral charge title usually reflects the breadth of the geographic area encompassing the charge.

Kings United Pastoral Charge is located on Prince Edward Island. Communities of faith are at Bay Fortune and Dundas.

In 1925, upon the formation of The United Church of Canada, the Methodist circuit of Souris and Bridgetown was divided, the latter forming part of the Dundas Charge and Souris Methodist uniting with the Presbyterian Churches at Bay Fortune and Souris. Annandale, which had belonged to Souris-Bay Fortune Presbyterian congregation was made part of the Dundas Pastoral Charge.

In 1925, Souris Pastoral Charge contained the preaching points of Souris and Bay Fortune. The name was changed to Souris-Bay Fortune Pastoral Charge in 1995.

On January 1, 2005, the pastoral charge was realigned so that Souris and Bay Fortune became part of Kings United Pastoral Charge along with Dundas and Annandale from the former Central Kings Pastoral Charge. Annandale and Souris were closed in 2011.

Effective January 1, 2019, The United Church of Canada underwent some structural changes including the elimination of all Presbyteries. At this time, Alberton-Elmsdale Pastoral Charge became part of the Fundy St. Lawrence Dawning Waters Regional Council.

**Custodial History:** Information about the custody of these records prior to acquisition is incomplete.

Annandale, which had belonged to Souris-Bay Fortune Presbyterian congregation was made part of the Dundas Pastoral Charge.

**Title:** Souris Methodist Circuit records

**Dates:** 1863-1925

**Extent:** 7 cm of textual records

**Administrative History:** Travelling Methodist preachers had been visiting the Souris area as early as 1825. In 1858, William Ryan was settled in the Kings County Mission which included Souris. Land was purchased in 1863 where the Union Protestant Cemetery is today and a Union church was built for the use of all Protestants, the two major groups being Presbyterian and Methodist. This building was sold in 1878. The Methodists built their own church in 1873. Upon church union in 1925, the Presbyterian building became the new United Church while the Methodist church building became the church hall.

**Title:** Souris-Bay Fortune Presbyterian Pastoral Charge records

**Dates:** 1870-1925

**Extent:** 7 cm of textual records

**Administrative History:** The official beginning of the Presbyterian congregation in Bay Fortune is said to be in 1806, when Rev. Peter Gordon was inducted into the charge of St. Peter's, Covehead, and Bay Fortune.

The first building was constructed before 1815 on the farm of John McKie. A second church was built around 1834. In July 1843, West St. Peters and Covehead were disjoined from East St. Peters and Bay Fortune and became a separate congregation. In March 1858, Bay Fortune and Souris were separated from East and West St. Peters to become a congregation in their own right but this was reversed shortly after. In October 1872, Bay Fortune, Souris, and Grand River were again disjoined from St. Peters. A third church building was constructed in Bay Fortune in 1875. The Souris church was damaged by fire in November 1909, and re-opened in July 1910. The Presbyterian church in Souris became known as St. James in 1908.

In 1852, the Presbyterians in Souris joined with Bay Fortune and East St. Peter's in calling a minister.

Land was purchased in Souris in 1863 where the Union Protestant Cemetery is today and a Union church was built for the use of all Protestants, the two major groups being Presbyterian and Methodist. This building was sold in 1878. The Presbyterians started construction on a church building shortly after but a windstorm in April 1879 blew down the partially constructed building. It was decided to build the church on another plot of land and the church was officially dedicated on December 20, 1879.

In 1925, the Presbyterian churches in Souris and Bay Fortune became part of The United Church of Canada.
