Petite Riviere Pastoral Charge (Nova Scotia)

Title: Petite Riviere Pastoral Charge fonds

Dates: 1813-1850; 1855-2009; 2012-2019

Extent: 1.7 metres of textual records

Administrative History: A pastoral charge consists of one or more communities of faith (formerly known as preaching points before 2019) under the spiritual leadership of a minister. The pastoral charge title usually reflects the breadth of the geographic area encompassing the charge.

The Petite Riviere Pastoral Charge consists of the appointments of Crousetown (St. Andrew's United), Danesville, Middlewood, and Petite Riviere (Wesley United) All are located in Lunenburg County.

In 1925, the Methodists, Congregationalists, and a large percentage of the Presbyterians formed The United Church of Canada. In 1926, after the formation of The United Church of Canada, the Petite Riviere Pastoral Charge included the appointments of Broad Cove, Cherry Hill, Crousetown, Italy Cross and Petite Riviere. The Mill Village Pastoral Charge contained the appointments of Danesville, East Port Medway, Middlewood, Mill Village, Port Medway, and Vogler's Cove. Beach Meadows, Brooklyn, East Port Medway and Mill Village were moved to the Brooklyn Pastoral Charge in 1939.

In 1946, the appointments of Port Medway and Vogler's Cove were transferred from the Mill Village Pastoral Charge to the Petite Riviere Pastoral Charge, which included the points of Broad Cove, Cherry Hill, Crousetown, Petite Riviere, Port Medway and Vogler's Cove. Middlewood was formed as a separate Pastoral Charge in 1952 and contained the appointments of Danesville, Italy Cross and Middlewood.

In 1967, the Middlewood United Church was destroyed by fire. A school that had been purchased to be used as a church hall was remodelled to be used as the Middlewood United Church. In that same year, the Middlewood Pastoral Charge was amalgamated with the Petite Riviere Pastoral Charge which then contained the appointments of Broad Cove, Cherry Hill, Crousetown, Danesville, Italy Cross, Middlewood, Petite Riviere, Port Medway, and Vogler's Cove.

In 1970, Port Medway was moved to the Brooklyn Pastoral Charge and amalgamated with Bethany United Church. In that same year, the congregation of Cherry Hill was disbanded and amalgamated with the united congregations of Broad Cove and Vogler's Cove. The property on which the old Methodist Church at Cherry Hill stood was sold to the Broad Cove, Cherry Hill and Vogler's Cove Fire Department in 1973. Italy Cross was amalgamated with the congregation at Petite Riviere. The Italy Cross Church building was badly deteriorated when it was finally demolished in 1988.

St. John's United Church (Vogler's Cove) and St. Matthew's United Church (Broad Cove) were closed in 2008.

Effective January 1, 2019, The United Church of Canada underwent some structural changes including the elimination of all Presbyteries. At this time, Petite Riviere Pastoral Charge became part of the Regional Council 15.

Custodial History: Information about the custody of these records prior to acquisition is incomplete.

Title: Petite Riviere Methodist Circuit records

Dates: 1813-1850; 1855-1925

Extent: 49 cm of textual records

Administrative History: A Methodist Church at Petite Riviere was donated to the congregation in 1817. The present Wesley United Church was erected in 1866. In 1853, Petite Riviere was made a separate Methodist Circuit under the Halifax District. The circuit included Broad Cove, Cherry Hill, Crousetown, Italy Cross, LaHave, LaHave Islands, Mount Pleasant, Petite Riviere and West Dublin.

The appointment of Mill Village was separated from the Liverpool Methodist Circuit and made the head of a circuit in 1855. The appointments included East Port Medway, Mill Village, Port Medway and Vogler's Cove.

In 1891, the appointments of East Port Medway and Vogler's Cove were detached from the Mill Village Methodist Circuit and Broad Cove and Cherry Hill from the Petite Riviere Methodist Circuit and these four appointments formed a new circuit called Vogler's Cove. In 1894, Vogler's Cove was again connected with the Mill Village Methodist Circuit.

In 1919, La Have was made the head of a circuit under the Liverpool District with the appointments of LaHave, LaHave Islands, Mount Pleasant and West Dublin.

A Methodist church was erected at Broad Cove in 1844. In 1886, a church was built at Vogler's Cove. The present church at Broad Cove was built in 1902 and dedicated April 5, 1903. A Methodist church was erected at Crousetown in 1887 and was called the Methodist Meeting House. A church in Italy Cross was dedicated on June 10, 1900.

About 1890, the name Middleton was used for the community later called Middlewood. The Middlewood Methodist Church was built between 1900-1904 and dedicated on July 7, 1904.

In 1925, the Methodists, Congregationalists, and a large percentage of the Presbyterians formed The United Church of Canada. At this time, the churches on the Petite Riviere Methodist Circuit became part of The United Church of Canada.

It became the head of a separate pastoral charge in 1952 and contained the appointments of Danesville, Italy Cross and Middlewood.

In 1967, Middlewood United Church was destroyed by fire. A school that had been purchased to be used as a church hall was remodelled to be used as the Middlewood United Church. In that same year, the Middlewood Pastoral Charge, including Middlewood United Church, was amalgamated with the Petite Riviere Pastoral Charge.
