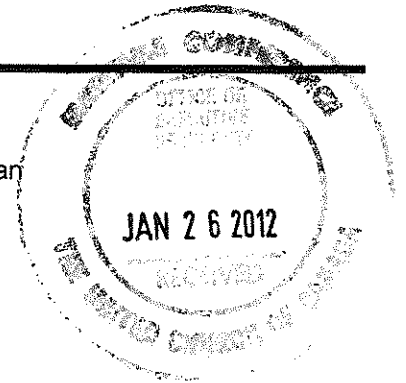

Hi David ,

I went with Brian Maclean from the MacLennan board to look at the kitchen equipment last week. There are several items in the kitchen that Camp Kidston can make use of and is prepared to invest the resources required to move the items to Kidston this spring before the beginning of the 2015 camp season. The items we are interested in obtaining are as follows:

- 108" L X 36"W overhead exhaust hood , ductwork , and roof top exhaust fan including integral fire suppression system.
- 2 6 burner propane stoves
- 1 24" x 18" propane cooktop
- 1 5 ft long chest type freezer
- 1 96" L x 36" W SS top food prep table
- 1 24" W x 24"D x 36"H front loading dishwasher
- 1 15 cu ft refrigerator freezer
- Some assorted small kitchen appliances

I have received an estimate from a contractor to uninstall , transport , and reinstall the exhaust hood system and our board has approved the expenditure of funds required to ensure a code compliant installation. The uninstall will also include a temporary water tight patch of the exhaust system roof opening . Kidston will secure the use of a moving truck and labour to move the remaining items. The work will be dependent on weather to access Camp MacLennan but would likely happen in the spring.

Brian Maclean has indicated his support for our plans but referred me to you for the approval of Maritime Conference prior to proceeding.
