The Israeli army expelled Heidar Abu Ghosh from his hometown of Imwas in 1967. It was subsequently demolished along with two other villages, and covered over by "Canada Park." Heidar, who lives in the Palestinian territories, is touring Canada to uncover this crime for Canadians and to suggest a path toward justice and peace.

Ismail Zayid, is a retired Halifax pathologist originally from Beit Nuba, one of the other two villages. His entire family was also expelled in 1967. Dr. Zayid has been a tireless campaigner for Palestinian rights for many decades
