St. Paul's United Church is an urban church with a country feel and a warm welcoming congregation. Our modern facility is accessible and suited for a wide variety of activities. We are located in Halifax at the corner of Old Sambro Road, Rockingstone Road, and Sussex Street in Halifax.

We are searching for a qualified, responsible, and creative musician able to play and lead worship music. Responsibilities include providing organ/piano music for worship services in consultation with our minister & worship team members, leading choir practices, and coordinating the use of other musical talents.

The Choir has 10 regular members and meets on Monday nights to practice. They practice music for the next service and prepare special music for some Sundays, Advent, Christmas and Easter. Other congregational members often join the choir members for funerals. There is a Men's Choir put together for Remembrance Day.

The ideal candidate would be capable of playing the Church Organ and directing the Choir. Additional duties include playing at funerals and weddings. This is a part time paid position. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

We have a seven member Bell Choir that meets on Wednesday evenings. Its goal is to provide special music at 7-8 week intervals. New members are always welcome and no musical background is required.

St. Paul's also has a Worship Band that meets on Thursday evenings. At present there are 14 members, both men and women of all ages, who share a love of music but are not necessarily musically trained. The group consists of some people who play various types of instruments including: ukulele, guitar, mandolin, piano, rhythm instruments and sometimes more. They all love to sing. This group looks after the worship service music about six times a year in consultation with the Minister. The choir can sit in the congregation those Sundays and the organist has an opportunity to take the Sunday off with pay.
