Title: Sydney: Trinity Pastoral Charge fonds

Dates: 1900-2014

Extent: 1.5 metres of textual records and 14 photographs

Administrative History: A pastoral charge is a grouping of churches termed "preaching points" -- each with separate names and governing boards or sessions. These churches were served by one minister. The pastoral charge title usually reflected the breadth of the geographic area encompassing the charge.

In 1925, the Congregational, Methodist and most Presbyterian Churches were united into one denomination--The United Church of Canada. At this time, St. James Presbyterian Church, St. Mark's Presbyterian Church, and Victoria Methodist Church in Sydney all joined The United Church of Canada.

In the summer months, St. James United Church held services together with Victoria United Church. Trinity United Church was created in 1937 when St. James United Church, St. Mark's United Church, and Victoria United Church amalgamated. Trinity United Church continued using the St. James United Church building after the amalgamation.

The United Mission became a mission of Trinity United Church in 1937. In 1955, the United Mission became the responsibility of Sydney Presbytery of The United Church of Canada. The United Mission was closed in 2006.

On October 19, 2014, First United Church, St. Andrews United Church, Trinity United Church, and The United Baptist Church amalgamated to form United Heritage Church.

Custodial History: Information about the custody of these records prior to acquisition is incomplete.

Scope and Content: Fonds consists of baptism/marriage/burial records, membership rolls, minutes, financial ledgers, reports, orders of service, and photographs from Trinity Pastoral Charge and its Methodist and Presbyterian antecedents.

Title: St. James Presbyterian Church (Sydney) records

Dates: 1900-1925

Extent: 19 cm of textual records

Administrative History: In the late nineteenth century, a Presbyterian congregation known as St. James Presbyterian Church was established in Whitney Pier, Sydney. The congregants originally worshipped at St. Andrews Presbyterian Church. However, rapid growth in the Presbyterian population within the area due to the booming steel industry necessitated the creation of a new church. The first church was built on July 3, 1900. This building was destroyed by fire on July 29, 1906. A new church was constructed and dedicated on October 2, 1907. St. James Presbyterian Church joined The United Church of Canada in 1925.

Title: St. Mark's Presbyterian Church (Sydney) records

Dates: 1906-1918

Extent: 3 cm of textual records

Administrative History: St. Mark's Presbyterian Church was created in March 1901 by Falmouth Street Presbyterian Church to serve a growing population within that region of Sydney. However, the church struggled to establish itself as the congregants would move on quickly. It began as a Mission Church but was then changed to have Ordained Mission Status, and later again to the status of an Augmented Charge. St. Mark's Presbyterian Church was placed into the care of St. James Presbyterian Church on February 4, 1919. In 1925, St. Mark's Presbyterian Church joined The United Church of Canada.

Title: Victoria United Church (Sydney) records

Dates: 1925-1937

Extent: 14 cm of textual records

Administrative History: Victoria Methodist Church became Victoria United Church in 1925. In the summer months, Victoria United Church held services together with St. James United Church in the summer months. Victoria United Church merged with St. James United Church and St. Mark's United Church in 1937 to form Trinity United Church. The Victoria Church building was closed and later sold.

Administrative History: The United Mission, located on the corner of Lingan Road and Laurier Street, was established by the Methodist Missionary Society in 1912 to serve the many immigrants who lived in the vicinity. At this time, it was known as the Italian Mission (Protestant) before it came under the joint sponsorship of the Presbyterian and Methodist Missionary Societies. After the formation of The United Church of Canada in 1925, the mission became known as the United Mission. In 1937, the United Mission became a mission of Trinity United Church. In 1955, the United Mission became the responsibility of Sydney Presbytery of The United Church of Canada. The United Mission was closed by Sydney Presbytery on June 30, 2006.
