Title: Loggieville-Black River Pastoral Charge fonds

Dates: 1834-2021

Extent: 83.5 cm of textual records and 4 microfilms

Administrative History: A pastoral charge consists of one or more communities of faith (known as preaching points prior to 2019) under the spiritual leadership of a minister. The pastoral charge title usually reflects the breadth of the geographic area encompassing the charge.

The Loggieville-Black River Pastoral Charge is comprised of four communities of faith-Black River Bridge (St. Stephen's), Napan (Carmel), Hardwicke (Myer's), and Loggieville (Knox)-located in Northumberland County, New Brunswick around Miramichi Bay.

In 1925, the Congregational, Methodist and most Presbyterian Churches were united into one denomination--The United Church of Canada. At this time, the Presbyterian churches in Loggieville, Black River Bridge, Bay du Vin, and Napan voted to become part of The United Church of Canada. Loggieville was its own separate pastoral charge while Black River contained the appointments of Black River Bridge, Napan, and Hardwicke.

In 1960, Loggieville and Millbank joined together to become the Loggieville-Millbank Pastoral Charge. Four years later, in 1964, Loggieville Pastoral Charge and Black River Pastoral Charge amalgamated to become Loggieville-Black River Pastoral Charge. The new pastoral charge included the appointments of Black River Bridge, Hardwicke, Loggieville, and Napan. Millbank became an appointment of Tabusintac Pastoral Charge at this time.

Effective January 1, 2019, The United Church of Canada underwent some structural changes including the elimination of all Presbyteries. At this time, Loggieville-Black River Pastoral Charge became part of the Fundy St. Lawrence Dawning Waters Regional Council.

Custodial History: Information about the custody of these records prior to acquisition is incomplete.

Title: Loggieville Presbyterian Pastoral Charge records

Dates: 1880; 1885; 1896-1925

Extent: 0.5 cm of textual records and 1 microfilm

Administrative History: Initially known as Black Brook, Loggieville traces its Presbyterian origins to 1895. In that year local Presbyterians, who had previously been required to attend St. Andrew's Church in Chatham, decided to form a congregation in their own locale. At a meeting on March 27, 1896 a formal request was made to Miramichi Presbytery to establish a church in the community and on 7 May of that year, permission was granted. In addition to the school house, early services were held at the Temperance Hall until the construction of the Knox Church which was dedicated on 22 May 1904.

In 1925 all these churches voted to become part of the new United Church of Canada.

Title: Black River Bridge Presbyterian Pastoral Charge records

Dates: 1834-1925

Extent: 0.5 cm of textual records and 3 microfilms

Administrative History: The first minister at St. Stephen's Presbyterian Church in Black River Bridge, the Rev. Simon Fraser of Inverness, Scotland, presided at the opening of the church on 20 November 1836. That structure was used until 1903, when a new building was begun. The new church was completed in 1906. There was also a Presbyterian Church at nearby Bay du Vin which was built in 1812, but the congregation had no pastor until 1837. In 1877 a Presbyterian work in Napan became a part of the Black River Congregation, but Carmel Presbyterian Church in Napan was not built until 1883. In 1925 these churches became part of The United Church of Canada.
