**Title:** Restigouche Pastoral Charge fonds

**Dates:** 1891-1994; 2001; 2003-2019; 2021

**Extent:** 85.5 cm of textual records, 1 photograph, and 4 microfilms

**Administrative History:** A pastoral charge consists of one or more communities of faith (known as preaching points prior to 2019) under the spiritual leadership of a minister. The pastoral charge title usually reflects the breadth of the geographic area encompassing the charge.

The Restigouche Pastoral Charge consists of the communities of faith of Glen Levit and Tide Head (St. Andrew's) which are both located in Restigouche County, New Brunswick.

In 1925, the Congregational, Methodist, and most Presbyterian Churches were united into one denomination--The United Church of Canada. At this time, Restigouche Pastoral Charge, under Miramichi Presbytery, contained the appointments of Restigouche, Flatlands, Kempt Road, Sellarsville, and Glen Levit. Tide Head was added in 1929.

In 1925, Matapedia was its own pastoral charge. By 1926, it also included the appointments of Runnymede, Deeside, Riverside, Upsalquitch, and Robinsonville. Riverside no longer appeared as a preaching point by 1932. Squaw Cap was listed as an appointment between 1937 and 1940.

In 1952, Sillarsville became part of the Escuminac Pastoral Charge. Matapedia and Restigouche Pastoral Charges were re-organized to form the Matapedia-Restigouche Pastoral Charge which included the preaching points of Matapedia, Flatlands, Glen Levit, Tide Head, Robinsonville, and Upsalquitch. Kempt Road was closed at this time. By 1955, Upsalquitch and Robinsonville had formed their own pastoral charge.

St. Andrew's United Church at Tide Head was built in 1956. When Matapedia United Church closed in 1978, the pastoral charge once again became Restigouche Pastoral Charge and included the appointments of Glen Levit, Tide Head, and Flatlands.

Flatlands United Church closed in 2010.

Effective January 1, 2019, The United Church of Canada underwent some structural changes including the elimination of all Presbyteries. At this time, Restigouche Pastoral Charge became part of the Fundy St. Lawrence Dawning Waters Regional Council.

**Custodial History:** Information about the custody of these records prior to acquisition is incomplete.

Microfilms were received from the Provincial Archives of New Brunswick in 1993 and 1996.

**Title:** Restigouche Presbyterian Pastoral Charge records

**Dates:** 1891-1925

**Extent:** 20.5 cm of textual records and 2 microfilms

**Administrative History:** The combined history of the churches goes back to 1831 when Flat Lands became a Presbyterian ministry. In 1872, Flat Lands, New Brunswick and Flat Lands, Québec were joined with Matapedia as a mission station. In 1884, a church was built at Flat Lands, and ten years later, another was built at Tide Head (Moffat's Siding). The cook house at Moffat's Grist Mill was moved from a site on the Tide Head beach to the Alford property on the (present) Stewart Highway. This building was converted into a church and served the Presbyterian congregation.

Until 1906, the Restigouche congregation was served by the minister of the church at Campbellton. After this time, the Restigouche Congregation was formed from Tide Head, Grand Levit, Sillarsville and Kempt Road (with a separate minister). In 1909, the church at Flat Lands became part of the Restigouche congregation, and a new Presbyterian Church was built at Sillarsville. In 1925, the Presbyterian, Methodist and Congregational churches were united to form The United Church of Canada and these preaching places became part of the new denomination.

By 1955, Upsalquitch and Robinsonville had formed their own pastoral charge.

When Matapedia United church closed in 1978, the pastoral charge once again became Restigouche Pastoral Charge and included the appointments of Glen Levit, Tide Head, and Flatlands.

Flatlands United Church closed in 2010.
