It is with sadness we announce the passing of Reverend Cora Krommenhoek at the Dr. Everett Chalmers Health Centre in Fredericton on March 9, 2026. Born Cornelia Maria Krommenhoek in Gorinchem (Gorkum), The Netherlands to Dirk and Ida Maria (Weergang) Krommenhoek on December 26, 1956, Cora came to Canada as a small child.
